

Comprehensive training modules and individual support from the Altiorem team and other experienced mentors will be available to guide you through the process.

You will be expected to complete research summary reviews within 4 weeks of starting them and can work on up to 2 at a time. Research summaries can take between 2-4 hours to review depending on the length and complexity of the research.
